### **DRIVING DIRECTIONS**


If you are arriving via car and have a GPS / SatNav system in the car, please use [Sargent Equestrian Center, Lodi, CA (not the physical address)].

When you arrive at our **security gate**, you should have the code, but if some reason you do not, use the keypad at the gate to contact us so we can let you in. Drive down the long driveway, **DRIVE SLOW PLEASE**, when you get to the intersection you will see the Farm House on your left (with wrap around porch). Please park to the West side of the house. You will by now have been given instructions for access. Important note: we have Livestock Guardian Dogs working the property at all times, if you have ANY fear of dogs please let us know so we can handle that as appropriate.

### **ACCESS CODES / INSTRUCTIONS**

Due to the sensitive nature of this information we will email access codes including the security gate code and house door key code separately. Rest assured they change after every guest for your safety and security.

Check-in time is 4pm. We can sometimes arrange an early check-in so please contact us if you would like to arrive early and we'll do our best, without any promises! We suggest you refer to the section on what to do if you arrive early there is plenty to keep you entertained!



### **GETTING HERE WITHOUT A CAR**

If arriving from the San Francisco Airport (1 hr 45 min – 3 hours depending on traffic) or Sacramento airport (1 hr – 1hr 30), please use the driving directions above. If arriving from the bus or train station use the Lodi Transit station (about 20 minutes from the property using a Ride Share or Taxi).



### **INVENTORY CHECK-IN**

We have an inventory of items, utensils, linens, games etc. Please let us know if you would like to review the inventory when you check in. You will be charged for any damaged or missing items on checkout.

### **PARKING**

Ample parking is provided on site. Please park to the West side of the Farm House. There is no covered parking. Do not park directly under any trees as occasionally branches will fall off the tree.





# **DEPARTURE INFORMATION**

### **CHECK-OUT TIME**



Check-out time is **11am**. Should you require a later check-out we will do our best but you need to let us know beforehand. If we have guests arriving that day it will be almost impossible to offer a late check-out due to the cleaners needing to prepare for those guests. Be sure to "write & create" in our **guest book**. Write a quick note, draw, color or whatever you like. Put in information like where you are traveling from, going to, number of people, ages...etc.

### **CHECK-OUT PROCESS**

When you leave, please ensure the following simple tasks are done:

- ensure the air-conditioning is set to 85F / 29C
- run the dishwasher

### **CLEANING**

You will find the house clean on arrival but please let us know if you are not satisfied. For stays of 1 week or less there is no cleaning service. After you depart our cleaners will perform that for the next guest. If you are here for two weeks there will be one clean, by request at a time arranged. If you need a cleaning service more often, please let us know and we will arrange this. An extra payment of \$75/cleaning will apply. On departure it would be helpful if you could leave the house (particularly kitchen contents and bbq/grill) clean and tidy. No need for you to perform a full clean!

### INVENTORY CHECK

Housekeeping will do this on check out. You will be charged for any missing items.

We hope you enjoyed our Farm House, Equestrian Center and Estates as much as we do. Our goal is that you'll want to come back! Safe travels back home.

- Catch a concert or play at the Hutchins Street Square performing arts theatre
- Hike, bike, swim or fish at Lodi Lake
- Paddle or kayak the Mokelumne River just a hop, skip and jump away.
- Cycle through Lodi Wine Country
- Golf at one of many Lodi golf courses
- View nature at one of several surrounding <u>nature preserves</u>
- Camanche Reservoir with recreation areas offering activities like swimming, fishing, camping, boating & water skiing. 20-minute drive

### **Wagon Rides**

Relax, unwind and take in the sights as you travel along our scenic trails. Enjoy a leisurely **horse drawn carriage or wagon ride** around the estates. *Wagon Rides* take you back to a simpler time; a time for family and friends, a time to relax, and a time to enjoy our estates including our vineyards, pastures, horses, creek and native trees, grasses and plants. Each *ride* is approximately 45 minutes guided.

- 1 to 4 guests \$200/45 minutes
- More than 4 guests additional \$25/person

### **Walking Tours**

We also offer a "walking tours" of horses, barns and grounds. Each tour is designed for you to meet your requests. Tours usually include the horse barns introducing several breeds of horses, also meeting the chickens and desert tortoises. You will have a chance to take lots of pictures up close with the animals, ask questions, touch and feed the horses carrots.

# LOCAL FOOD SCENE "Our Personal Favorites"

There are truly many good restaurants in Lodi and nearby, we have listed some of our personal favourites (In no particular order). Tell them Sargent sent you!

### Yume Japanese, Lodi - (10.3 miles) (209) 224-5169

Yume, meaning "dream" in Japanese, in which lies the chef Masayuki Hattori's "Masa" has a passon for a real Japanese taste. A cosy restaurant with a sushi bar which offers different varieties of both traditional and modern Japanese dishes with ingredients sourced both domestically and internationally. Chef Hattori is a strong believer in that the food he serves is the pride of his Japanese heritage. Enjoy!

### Piatro's Trattoria, Lodi - (8.6 miles) (209) 368-0613



Slice of Italy in Lodi's wine country. Authentic Italian cuisine. Seating inside, at the bar or outside in a beautiful garden. Uses the farm to fork method, with many dishes' ingredients coming fresh from the kitchen garden right outside the restaurant. A true delight!

### Thai Spices, Lodi - (10.3 miles) (209) 369-8424

Traditional Thai dishes, from spicy curries to noodles, presented in a relaxed genuine Thai atmosphere. Same goes for the food, which is well prepared, fresh and authentic. Good service and food. Good option for vegans and vegetarians. Recommend!

### **Coyotes Mexican, Lockeford - (3.7 miles)** (209) 727-5900

Coyotes is on top of our list of places to go for a meal when you just don't feel like cooking. It is close, has a great atmosphere, staff, drinks (full bar), and most importantly food! Real ingredients, well prepared, perfect balance of seasoning and heat. Good option for vegans and vegetarians. Relish!

### **Towne House Restaurant at Wine and Roses, Lodi - (10.5 miles)**



The **Lodi Wine & Visitor Center** is located on the grounds, so wine tasting information, maps, and advice are easily accessible.

Towne House Restaurant is a Beautiful, romantic atmosphere. They have a serene view from the patio, and a savoury fresh menu featuring innovative dishes using the highest quality seasonal and regionally sourced ingredients. Delicious! A stroll around the grounds is a must. Make sure to check out the birds including Macaws, African Greys and more.

### The **Towne House Lounge** is the perfect place to

relax and enjoy live music, extraordinary cuisine, specialty cocktails, and fine wine. They offer cooking classes and demonstrations throughout the year. Recommend reservations.





### Lodi Beer, Historic Downtown Lodi - (8.3 miles) (209) 368-9931

**Lodi Beer (10.5 miles)** - A range of house beers to pair with a diverse menu of comfort-food in an old-fashioned tavern setting. Their huge menu is, consistently good! This is a go-to spot for food and drinks, especially when everyone in the family is in the mood for something different (lots of variety on the menu).

### Donkey J's Deli & Ice Cream Shop, Lockeford - (3.8 miles)



Local favourite. Family owned and run deli style. They have great sandwiches, ice cream, coffee, Frappuccino's, and cookies. Hometown feels. They serve breakfast too! **Hours 6am to 4pm (closed Sunday).** 

### Farm Café at Michael David Winery - (14.4 miles) (209) 368-7384

Breakfast and Lunch. Expansive grounds & gardens, onsite cafe, gourmet produce, and award-winning bakery, playground for the kids and Bocce Ball Courts. Wine tasting with some pretty fantastic wine too. There's something for everyone. Be prepared to wait 30-45 minutes for a table. But that's usually not a problem, since you can just do some wine tasting or stroll the grounds while you wait. So beautiful, kids love it, and great scenery for photographs. Bring home a award winning homemade pie. © Hours: Café 7:30am-3:00pm. Winery and grounds 7:30am-5:00pm.

### Dancing Fox Restaurant, Winery & Brewery, Lodi - (10.5 miles) (209) 366-2634



Family owned and operated. Atmospherically it really encompasses the town and region. The building and interior are beautiful, if you are in the mood for a little European feel don't skip this location. Very small, quaint wine tasting room but full of story, art and history, abundant with a fun personality. Great wines. From the menu I like the bruschetta, pizza (cooked in a stone pizza oven) and salads. But everything on the menu is good. They bake their own breads and pastries. They do not take reservations and it can get quite busy so if there's a wait, don't worry, go

back to the wine bar for wine tasting which is free with your dinner. Hours: Tues-Thurs 11:00am-9:00pm. Fri-Sat 11:00am-10:00pm; Sun (Brunch) 9:00am-3:00pm.

### Waterloo Restaurant/BB-Q- (10.3 miles) (209) 931-4019

This place is the way to go if you are craving ribs, steak, pasta and great drinks. Well known for their ribs and baseball memorabilia collection. The family run restaurant has a lot of good BBQ staples served with sides



like a baked potato, soup, house salad, spaghetti or pasta! All items are prepared fresh and are of the highest quality. Be sure and be hungry because they have overwhelming portions. You can hang out at the bar and eat or grab a table for the whole family. Please sit back and enjoy the whole "Waterloo Experience". There may be a little wait for a table, but I



think you will agree that it is well worth your valuable time and money. It's a little crowded and noisy and if you prefer not to wait, the whole menu can be prepared to go.

### Foothill Pizza - (3.4 miles) (209)263-4680



We recommend this place when you are craving pizza, in a super convenient place and easy parking! Just a couple of minutes away so get pizza to go and enjoy it at the Farm House.



### Rosewood Bar & Grill, Lodi - (10.5 miles) (209) 369-0470

Located in charming downtown Lodi, Rosewood is a Classic American market inspired cuisine in a

casual, modern environment with a full bar and outdoor dining. It pretty much has something for everyone and every price point. You can choose a nice steak or have an amazing brick oven pizza. The chef makes some very interesting and delicious dishes. Rosewood partners with local farmers to bring the best seasonal ingredients to the menu. They are committed to using the best available meats including free range and grass fed whenever possible. All the seafood is sustainable, whether farmed or



wild. Delish! Recommend reservations or sit at the bar. Hours: Sunday, Tuesday-Thursday 5pm, Friday and Saturday 5pm – 8pm, Closed Mondays, Bar Opens daily at 4pm. Happy Hour 4-6pm.





# WHAT ELSE....

It is hard to know where to start. But here are a few ideas.

### Mokelumne River Day Use Area and Hatchery - (8.3 miles) (209)772-8204

25800 N McIntire Rd, Clements, CA 95227



This is so close and gives access to the river. Popular activities include picnicking, strolling along trails, bird watching, kayaking, canoeing, wading & swimming and fishing for steelhead and salmon. This park also affords rafting access to a beautiful stretch of river downstream.

Of special interest is the salmon spawning season, which is generally October through December. During this time, many large adult chinook salmon can be seen returning from the ocean. In November, at the peak of spawning season, hatchery visitors can watch the staff collect eggs. The Mokelumne River Fish Hatchery, operated by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife. **Hours: open seven days a week, from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** 

Camanche Reservoir (18.8 miles <a href="https://www.lakecamancheresort.com/">https://www.lakecamancheresort.com/</a>) is an artificial lake



with 54 miles of shoreline and 7,700 surface acres of water for all of your outdoor recreational activities like swimming, fishing, camping & water skiing. Fish for Rainbow trout, Largemouth bass, Bluegill, Smallmouth bass and Spotted bass.

### **Biglieri Farms, Clements CA-(6.6 miles)**




Close by, roadside fruit stand/farmers market. Great selection of homemade pies, breads, pastries, pasta, fudge, dried fruit & nuts that are prepared daily and very tempting. We also like to get the honey that is locally produced. The stop at this highway stand is well worth it. Yummy!!!!

### Lodi Lake Park-(10 miles) (209)772-8204

Calming and Lovely, Cute peaceful place to spend the afternoon! Swim, paddle boat, kayak hike and picnic with the family or walk along the nature trails to view the riparian habitat that is home to many species of mammals, reptiles, and fish .The Lodi Lake Boathouse is open weekends April through October, and

Wednesday through Sunday in June, July and August. **Paddle boards and kayaks** are available for rent at the Headwaters
Boat House at Lodi Lake. The Lodi Lake Boathouse offers
chartered 90-minute boat tours that cover nearly 5 miles of

river on Lodi's northern border. Trips are offered May through September. Food and beverages may be brought on board. Hours: The public beach is open in June, July, and August, Monday-Sunday from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day









### Lees' Feed and Western Store, Inc., Lockeford - (3.6 miles) (209)772-8204

**Lee's** is a one-stop-shop! You will find everything you're searching for a life on the ranch or the farm as well as great finds for "farm style" living. Shop for decorative items, clothes (inventory for men, women or kids) or gifts. Also, of course feed, feeders, hay, fencing, pet food. Close by so stop in and check it out. You will be glad you did!



### Lockeford Meat & Sausage Services - (3.4 miles) (209) 727-5584

Famous throughout Northern California. People literally drive hours to get here. You are probably going to have to wait outside regardless of the day but as you'll quickly realize there's a reason. The line moves fairly quick, and they take cash or credit cards.

Each sausage is roughly about half-a-pound, the breakfast sausages are smaller. The smoked Dakota is what they are known for, but they have a bunch of other varieties. The Hawaiian Luau is another favourite. Italian, Andouille, Bratwurst, Kielbasa, Bavarian, and the list goes on and on. The teriyaki sticks are packed with flavour and incredibly delicious!



They say the meat is good for 6 months so you can easily stash some for later if you wish. They have a few other things including bacon, marinated tri-tips and some sauces and seasonings. But really, this place is all about the sausage. Do yourself a favour and bring a large cooler to load up. You won't regret it.

# **ABOUT THE ACCOMMODATIONS**

## APPLIANCE INSTRUCTIONS / INFORMATION

### **EQUIPMENT INFORMATION/MANUALS**

All manuals for the electrical equipment and appliances are in the drawer left of the sink.

### AIR CONDITIONING

Our home has the benefit of air conditioning. You will find a panel on the wall between the two bedrooms. Please ensure that all windows and outside doors are closed whilst the AC is running to ensure it operates to maximum efficiency. We recommend a setting of [74F / 23C] which we find keeps the place sufficiently cool.

### **CEILING FANS**

Our home is equipped with ceiling fans to help keep you cool. Each fan is operated via a switch on the wall.

### **CENTRAL HEATING**

Our home has a central heating system. You will find a panel on the wall between the bedrooms. We recommend a setting of [69F / 20.5C] which we find keeps the place sufficiently warm.

### **FIREPLACE**

Unfortunately, our fireplace is currently not working. We are looking to replace it with a propane fireplace insert.

### **KITCHEN**

The Dishwasher:

It's very simple, we promise! We provide a supply of dishwashing soap under the sink. Press the program button of your choice - there are a few settings which are obvious - then press the start button.

### *The Fridge/freezer:*

You should not need to adjust any settings. If you run into any difficulties (e.g. it's not cooling efficiently) please let us know.

### **LAUNDRY APPLIANCES**

We have a full-size high efficiency washer and dryer located in the utility room next to the kitchen. There is a supply of HE detergent for your use. To operate the machines, simply select the program you want, place a small amount of the detergent in the tray, close the door, and hit start. If in any doubt, the instructions are in the binder in the drawer to the left of the sink in the kitchen.

If you like **Jigsaw Puzzles** as much as we do....there are a few good ones on the shelfs in the living area.






BOOKS

# ENJOYING YOUR TIME OUTSIDE

### HIKE AROUND THE ESTATES







There are many well defined trails/roads around the properties. Enjoy exploring them by foot anytime. Please do not go into any of the horse pastures. If you see a horse on the trail, just step to the side and let it pass.

### **CHAIRS / TABLES**

There is a picnic table in the back yard as well as a small child's picnic table. A small table with two chars on the Front Porch. Let us know if you need more tables or chairs for outside use.


### **GRILL / BBQ**

### IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES REGARDING THE ANIMALS ON THE RANCH

Horses and ponies are large, often unpredictable animals. They are beautiful and, at the same time, a potential hazard.








All our barns and pastures are <u>OFF LIMITS</u> to guests unless on a guided tour. You can walk/hike on any of our trails however if you see a horse coming, quietly move off to the side of the trial stand quietly and let it pass. You can observe the horses all day long being ridden, driven or lead just in front of your Farm House. Enjoy them. Please do not ask to pet or feed them. Do not touch or feed horses over the pasture fence without a guide.





Sargent's Livestock Guardian Dogs LGD's (Barsa, Squish and Sargent) are working dogs here at the ranch. They roam free and they apologize ahead of time if they bark at night "just doing our jobs so you can feel safe".





Our Livestock Guardian Dogs take

care of predators such as coyotes, racoons, skunks and "other undesirables" which can include humans. But they do know the difference. Our LGD's are highly bonded to their "flocks", including us and our livestock. They have a gentle, but firm, nature and a tolerant, calm temperament. Although sometimes aloof, they are overall great with people and enjoy attention, but it needs to be their choice. If the front door to the farm house is open, they may just walk in, look around and check everything out. They will usually then just leave. They think they own this ranch and that we are all visitors. Feel free to pet and love on them if they approach. Be careful with young children around them as children sometimes don't understand and hitting them, pulling on their ears, tails etc, sitting on them or trapping them may not be tolerated. Please do NOT FEED them. They are on very strict guidelines regarding diet.

### **PETS**

We would prefer you leave your pets at home. As you can see, we love our pets and all animals but because of our LGD's, which can be aggressive to outside animals (it is their job), it is best if you can leave yours at home. If this is not possible, call us and we will see what kind of arrangements we can make.

# LOCATION OF FIRE EXTINGUISHER

A fire extinguisher can be found in the kitchen just to the left of the sink on the wall.



YELLOW JACKETS are unfortunately common summer and fall pest here at Sargent Estates, they are primarily flying insects, similar to bees, but are more noticeably segmented with a very small 'waist.' They can sting multiple times, and their stings can be very painful. People who are allergic to their venom could have a severe reaction. We do have "pest professionals" coming on a regular basis to help control them. Please be prepared (Epi pen?) and be careful. Let us know if you see any.

We have **no poisonous SNAKES** on the property. In fact, *snakes* are extremely *beneficial*, eating unwanted rats and mice, the same rodents who harbour ticks bearing lyme disease. They play a very important role in the food chain as their ambushing techniques allow them to prey on otherwise elusive pests like the grasshopper. Please "Live and let Live"!




Our "local go-to market", literally a 5-minute drive,
