SEC is providing an opportunity to learn techniques directly from a master of training, long reining and driving horses.

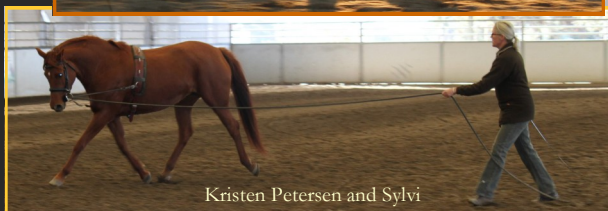

This Clay Maier Clinic Series hosted by SEC

for the beginner to advanced equestrian will start with each participant's current level and goals, and cover long reining topics for horses of various ages and levels: starting a young horse safely and confidently, a plan of action for developing flexion and collection with an experienced horse, and the steps leading to establishing better trust, respect and communication with your horse.

Participants will have one-on-one time with Clay working with your horse or one of ours as well as plenty of time to observe and ask questions. Clay will also perform demonstrations working on some problems as well as with some very young, green horses.

From the ground, we will become better able to observe some of the causes of challenges our horses have, for instance, "one-handed-ness," and learn techniques to gain suppleness in lateral movement from head to hip, left and right.

SEC will have a limited number of horses available for students in case you are unable to bring your own.
